

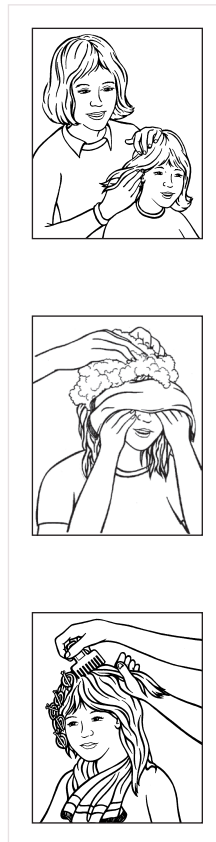


HOW-TO-USE GUIDE FOR NIX[®] LICE TREATMENT



Children with head lice need to be treated. The most common treatment is a medicated cream, lotion, or shampoo, such as Nix[®] Crème Rinse, which is applied to the scalp and hair. Detailed application instructions for Nix[®] Crème Rinse are provided below:

- 1 Wash your child's hair with a normal shampoo *without conditioner* and then rinse with water.
- 2 Towel dry hair so that it is damp but not wet.
- 3 Saturate your child's hair and scalp with your treatment. Don't forget to get behind the ears and the back of the neck.
- 4 Protect your child's eyes with a washcloth or towel.
- 5 The treatment should be left on your child's head for the designated period of time stated on your product packaging. Nix[®] Crème Rinse should be left in for 10 minutes, but no longer.
- 6 Rinse your child's hair with warm water and towel dry. Comb out tangles.
- 7 If live lice are seen seven days or more after the first treatment, a second treatment should be given.
