YIKES! DOES MY CHILD HAVE LICE?


THERE ARE SOME TELLTALE SIGNS THAT YOUR CHILD HAS LICE. THE MOST COMMON IS ITCHING, WHICH IS THE BODY'S REACTION TO THE BITES FROM LICE. OTHER THINGS TO LOOK FOR:



← **Lice are tiny—about the size of a sesame seed.** They can be tan, brown, or gray. Using bright light and a magnifying glass, check your child's scalp, behind the ears, and around the nape of the neck.



← **Lice eggs (called nits) are easier to see than lice** because they're stationary and appear in larger numbers. Look for tiny, white, oval-sized eggs attached to hair near the scalp. They may look like dandruff, but unlike dandruff, nits can't be removed by shaking, brushing, or washing.



← **Small red bumps may result from scratching.** There may be scabs, blood spots, or red marks on the scalp, behind the ears, or on the back of the neck.

CHIN UP!
Lice actually prefer clean hair, so they don't signal poor hygiene.

NOW WHAT? HOW TO LOSE THE LICE

ELIMINATING LICE IS ACTUALLY PRETTY EASY. IT JUST TAKES A LITTLE TIME, PATIENCE, AND THESE THREE STEPS:

Step 1

➔ Use NIX® ULTRA.

Follow directions for applying and rinsing NIX® ULTRA solution carefully. Proper use of the product is the first step to remove super lice and regular lice from your child's hair.

Step 2

➔ Use NIX Professional Lice Removal Comb (part of the NIX® ULTRA kit) to remove nits. Part wet hair into sections and work one section at a time. Pin hair back after you comb out the nits so you know which sections are done. Clean the comb as you go by wiping the nits off with a tissue and throwing the tissue in a sealed plastic bag. Soak nit comb in hot water (above 130° F) before reuse. **Check hair after 7 days. Repeat steps 1 to 3 if necessary.**

Step 3

➔ Clean your home and your child's personal items.

This cuts down on her chances of catching lice again, and it protects other family members.

➔ **Vacuum** furniture, rugs, car seats, and throw pillows to remove lice or hair that's fallen from your child's head. Use **NIX® Control Spray** for hard-to-clean surfaces such as furniture and mattresses.

➔ **Soak** combs, brushes, clips, and headbands in hot water (above 130 °F) for 10 minutes.

➔ **Wash** personal items such as hats, clothes, and bed linens in hot water (above 130 °F). After washing, dry them in the dryer's hot cycle for at least 20 minutes.

➔ **Dry clean** items that can't be washed (blankets, stuffed animals) or seal in a plastic bag for 2 weeks.
